

There are four types of schedules that can be generated:

- **Weekly** – This is based on a day of the week. This can be a single day or multiple days per week.
- **Interval** – An *Interval* is based on number of days between delivery such as every 45 days.
 - Schedule generation can be based off last delivery date, or every X number of days regardless of last delivery.
- **Monthly** – *Monthly* can be based on the day of the month or every X number of weeks/day.
- **Single** – Use this option for a one-time delivery that takes place outside of a normal delivery period.
