When an Out of Gas situation occurs (*Start* % = 0), the driver can select this button to perform an Out of Gas check. If the driver does not utilize this function on the Invoice screen, EnergyTrack will automatically prompt for an Out of Gas check once the **Continue** button is selected to finalize an Invoice.

1. Choose a Status of Passed, Failed, or Not Done. If Not Done is selected, enter a Signature and choose Continue.
